### About "Dragon 100" 2026

In 2026, under the theme **Cultural Inheritance and Modern Industries (文化傳承與現代產業)**, the programme turns to **Kunming (昆明)** and **Dali (大理)** in Yunnan (雲南), regions where history and acceleration coexist in striking ways. As a strategic node within the Belt and Road Initiative and the Yangtze River Economic Belt, Yunnan offers more than economic relevance; it presents a living question: how can cultural depth and diversity endure amid rapid transformation? Home to rich minority cultures and globally recognised efforts in intangible cultural heritage preservation, Yunnan is also emerging as a frontier of sustainable and inclusive development. This year also coincides with the 90th anniversary of the Long March which provides a moment both for commemoration and reflection.
