「龍匯100」簡介

INTRODUCTION OF THE “DRAGON 100”

「龍匯100」是一項年度活動，匯聚100位具潛質的未來領袖——他們具備優秀技能、學術實力，並對社會有承擔。每年，「龍匯100」召集參加者匯聚香港，並前往內地至少一個城市考察，深入了解國家發展、中華歷史與文化。項目旨在讓參加者帶走創意、豐富的中華文化知識，以及更廣闊的人脈網絡。2002年至2025年，來自41個國家及地區、超過1900名參加者已參與「龍匯100」。

「龍匯100」2026以「文化傳承與現代產業」為主題，走進雲南昆明、大理與麗江——這三座歷史底蘊與高速發展交相輝映的城市。作為「一帶一路」倡議與長江經濟帶的重要戰略節點，雲南的價值不僅體現在經濟層面，更拋出了一個值得深思的現實命題：在急速的社會轉型之中，如何保存文化底蘊、延續多元人文內涵？雲南蘊藏豐富的少數民族文化，在非物質文化遺產保護方面亦享譽國際；與此同時，這片土地正逐步成為可持續發展、共融發展的前沿地帶。

The “Dragon 100” is an annual programme which brings together 100 future leaders, who have demonstrated skills, academic prowess and a commitment to the community. Each year Dragon 100 gathers delegates in Hong Kong and visits at least one city in China to learn the development of it as well as Chinese history and culture. Dragon 100 will ensure delegates return home with more innovative ideas, knowledge of Chinese culture and a wider network. From 2002 to 2025, over 1900 delegates from 41 countries / regions have participated in the Dragon 100.

In 2026, under the theme Heritage in a Changing Economy, the programme turns to Kunming, Dali and Lijiang in Yunnan, regions where history and acceleration coexist in striking ways. As a strategic node within the Belt and Road Initiative and the Yangtze River Economic Belt, Yunnan offers more than economic relevance; it presents a living question: how can cultural depth and diversity endure amid rapid transformation? Home to rich minority cultures and globally recognised efforts in intangible cultural heritage preservation, Yunnan is also emerging as a frontier of sustainable and inclusive development.

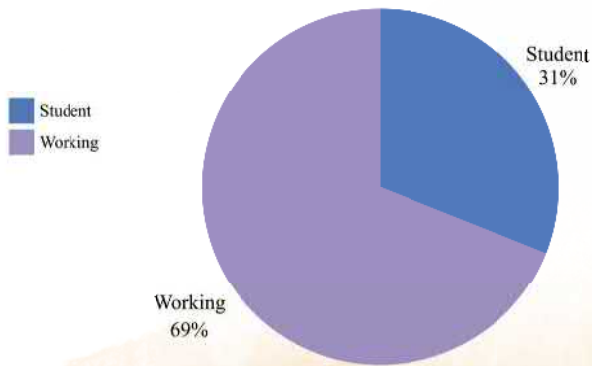

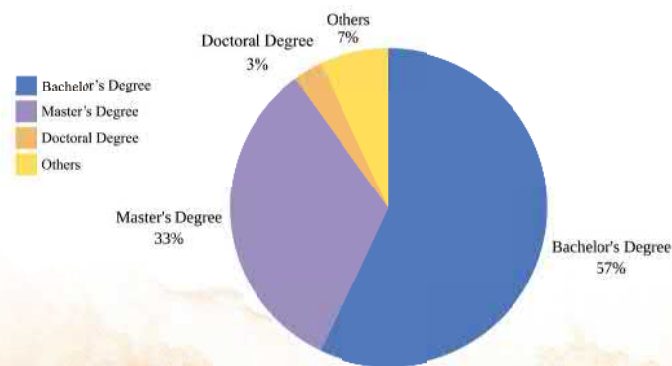

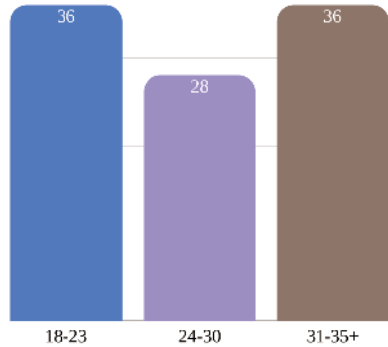

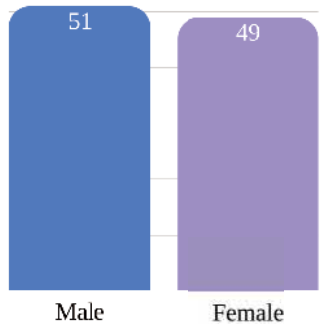

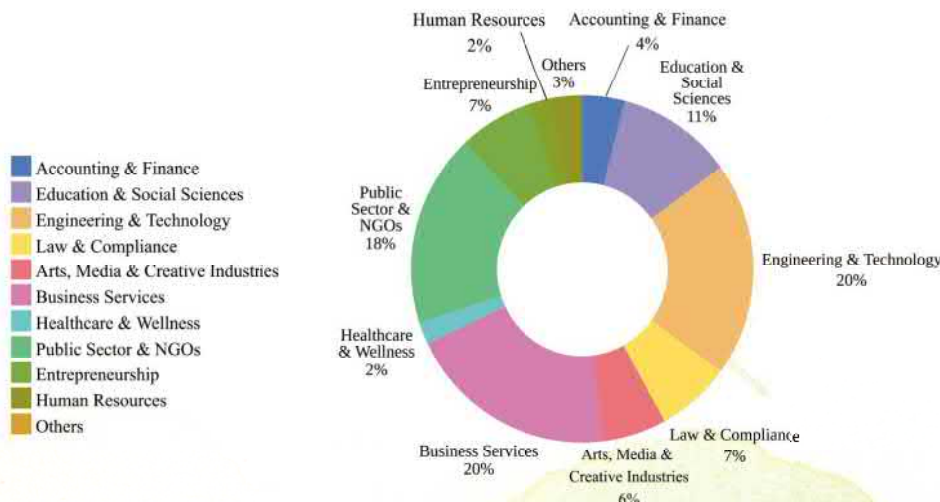

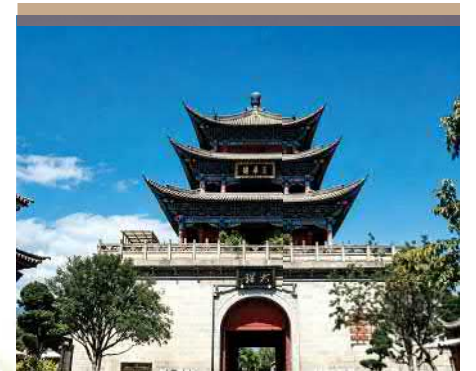


大理古城 DALI ANCIENT CITY

大理古城西枕蒼山、東臨洱海，為國家4A級景區及首批國家歷史文化名城。這裡曾是唐宋時期南詔國與大理國的都城，現存城池建於明代，保留著「九街十八巷」的棋盤格局與白族「三坊一照壁」的建築特色。

Nestled between Cangshan Mountain and Erhai Lake, Dali Ancient Town is a national 4A attraction and a renowned historical landmark. Serving as the capital of the Nanzhao and Dali kingdoms during the Tang and Song dynasties, its present Ming-dynasty grid layout features classic Bai architecture with traditional white-walled courtyards.

嚴家民居 YAN FAMILY RESIDENCE

位於大理喜洲——自古為白族聚居地與交通要道。喜洲是南詔時期的經濟重鎮，其商幫是茶馬古道上最具規模的商號網絡。嚴家民居被譽為「白族民居經典之作」，於2001年列入全國重點文物保護單位。大宅融匯精美木雕、石刻、彩繪與書法，極致展現白族建築美學。園區設有特色「三道茶」民俗表演與非遺工作坊，提供沉浸式文化體驗。

Located in Xizhou, Dali—a major economic hub since the Nanzhao Kingdom whose legendary merchants once dominated the Ancient Tea Horse Road—the Yan Family Residence is celebrated as a masterpiece of Bai architecture. Designated a Major Historical and Cultural Site Protected at the National Level in 2001, the complex showcases master craftsmanship through intricate woodcarving, stone masonry, decorative painting, and calligraphy. Visitors can also experience traditional Bai "Three-Course Tea" performances and hands-on heritage workshops.

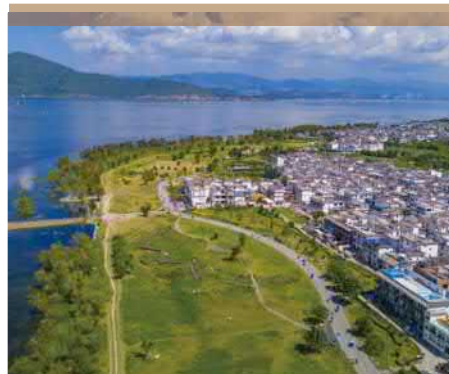


洱海生態廊道 ERHAI LAKE ECOLOGICAL CORRIDOR

洱海生態廊道全長 129 公里，總投資近 92 億元人民幣，為大理高原湖泊治理的標誌工程。項目貫徹「人退湖進」理念，修復近 800 公頃濕地，打造出綠色隔斷屏障。廊道全線實施機動車禁行，設慢行步道與觀光車線，串聯 23 個白族傳統村落，重現蒼山洱海與白族民居相融的人文生態美景。

The 129 km Erhai Lake Ecological Corridor (RMB 9.2B investment) is a flagship eco-restoration project in Dali. By relocating residents and restoring nearly 800 hectares of wetlands, it creates a vital green shield for the lake. This car-free corridor features scenic walking and cycling paths connecting 23 traditional Bai villages, beautifully fusing Cangshan Mountain views, crystalline waters, and traditional local heritage.

麗江古城 THE OLD TOWN OF LIJIANG

麗江古城別名大研鎮，坐落雲南麗江玉龍雪山腳下，1997年列入世界文化遺產、國家5A級景區。古城始建於宋末元初，是茶馬古道重要樞紐，獨特之處在於不設城牆。城內水系縱橫，石板街巷依地勢鋪設，匯聚四方街、木府等地標。作為納西族聚居地，這裡留存東巴文字、納西古樂等珍貴非遺，民居融合漢、藏、白族建築特色，高原水鄉風貌與多元民族文化交融，是中國保存最完整的少數民族古城之一。

Also known as Dayan Town, The Old Town of Lijiang sits beneath Jade Dragon Snow Mountain in Yunnan. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997, it is a national 5A scenic spot. Founded in the late Song and early Yuan dynasties, it served as a vital hub on the Ancient Tea Horse Road. Uniquely, the town has no city walls. Crisscrossed by waterways, its stone lanes follow natural terrain, featuring landmarks such as Sifang Street and the Mu Family Mansion. Home to the Naxi ethnic group, it preserves precious intangible heritage including Dongba script and ancient Naxi music. Local dwellings blend architectural styles of Han, Tibetan and Bai peoples. Boasting highland waterside scenery and diverse ethnic culture, it ranks among China's best-preserved ancient ethnic towns.

龍傳基金 THE DRAGON FOUNDATION

二零零零年為新世紀的開始，正值中國農曆的龍年。千禧時刻，香港特別行政區政府民政事務局及民政事務總署、香港青年協會以及中華全國青年聯合會合辦「千禧龍騰——海內外青年匯長城」計劃。

計劃包括在北京人民大會堂舉辦以「前瞻廿一世紀全球新趨勢及挑戰」為主題的「邁向新世紀研討會」，以及成功刷新舞動長龍健力士世界紀錄的「龍舞長城」。兩項大型青年交流活動共有超過三千名海內外華裔青年參與。

延續「邁向新世紀研討會」及「龍舞長城」兩項活動的精神，加上社會大眾的廣泛支持，龍傳基金於二零零零年二月十二日在香港正式註冊成立。基金為非牟利慈善機構，由獨立董事會管理，董事會委員包括香港特別行政區政府及香港青年協會委任的代表，以及社會各界的傑出人士。基金秘書處設於香港青年協會。

2000 was both the start of the new millennium and, according to the Chinese calendar, the Year of the Dragon. To commemorate these auspicious events, the Home Affairs Bureau and Home Affairs Department of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government, The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups and The All-China Youth Federation co-organised the project “Dragon at the Great Wall – Commemorating the New Millennium: A Vision for Youth”.

This special project included a youth conference, entitled, “Meeting the Challenges of the New Millennium”, with discussions focused on the theme, “Visualising the Trends of Global Development and the Challenges of the 21st Century”. Held at the Great Hall of the People in Beijing and attended by more than 3,000 Chinese youths from across the globe, the event culminated in raising a 10,000-foot-long dragon at the Great Wall which then successfully broke the current Guinness World Record for the longest dragon dance.

Following this successful event, and with community support and encouragement, The Dragon Foundation was set up, taking forward the aims manifested by Dragon at the Great Wall. The Foundation was established in Hong Kong and inaugurated on 12 February 2000. The Foundation is incorporated under the Companies Ordinance and registered as a non-profit, charitable organisation. The Foundation's Board of Directors includes representatives of the HKSAR Government, The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups and prominent leaders from various sectors of the community. The Foundation's Secretariat is administered by The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups.

THE HONG KONG JOCKEY CLUB

香港賽馬會(「馬會」)成立於1884年，是致力建設更美好社會的世界級體育及娛樂機構。馬會透過其結合賽馬及馬場娛樂、會員會所、有節制體育博彩及獎券，以及慈善及社區貢獻的獨特綜合營運模式，創造經濟及社會價值，並協助香港特區政府打擊非法賭博。2024/25年度，馬會回饋社會共391億港元。當中包括透過各項博彩稅、利得稅及獎券基金撥款，向香港特區政府貢獻301億港元，以及已審批慈善捐款90億港元。馬會是全港最大的單一納稅機構，也是香港主要僱主之一，其慈善信託基金是位居世界前列的慈善捐助機構。

Founded in 1884, The Hong Kong Jockey Club is a world-class sports and entertainment organisation that acts continuously for the betterment of our society. The Club has a unique integrated business model, comprising racing and racecourse entertainment, a membership club, responsible sports wagering and lottery, and charities and community contribution. Through this model, the Club generates economic and social value for the community and supports the HKSAR Government in combatting illegal gambling. In 2024/25, the Club returned a total of HK\$39.1 billion to the community. This included HK\$30.1 billion to the HKSAR Government in duty, profits tax and Lotteries Fund contributions and HK\$9.0 billion in approved charity donations. The Club is Hong Kong's largest single taxpayer and one of the city's major employers. Its Charities Trust is one of the world's leading charity donors.

The Hong Kong Federation of Youth Groups (HKFGY) was founded in 1960 and is now the city's largest youth service organisation. For the past six and a half decades, it has been committed to serving the youth of Hong Kong by providing a variety of services, activities and programmes, which have an annual attendance of over 4.5 million. We encourage youth to reach their fullest potential, and with community support, we now have over 90 service units. We also have 12 core services, which include the Youth S.P.O.Ts, M21 Multimedia Services, Employment Services, Youth at Risk Services, Counselling Services, Parenting Services, Leadership Training, Volunteer Services, Education Services, Creativity Education and Youth Exchange, Leisure, Cultural and Sports Services, and Research and Publications. Our aim is to motivate young people to grow into responsible and dutiful citizens and we now have over 260,000 registered volunteers and over 500,000 registered members.
